FAMILY RESEARCH LIBRARY

With over 40,000 volumes, the SCGS Family Research Library in Burbank, CA, holds one of the largest genealogical collections in the Southwestern U.S. The facility seats 60 and is handicapped accessible. Free off-street parking adjoins the building.

Research materials include geographic records, manuscripts, microforms, CDs and maps covering every state and many countries. The Society’s goal is to have at least one resource for every county in the United States. Examples of some of our extensive collections include:
