How to Publish and Market Your Family History Carl Boyer, III

Material on the internet is at best often distrusted, and at worse short-lived. Acid-free paper copies should last hundred of years. By organizing your project with publication in mind, you can publish a scholarly genealogy in book form without putting your own money into the printing costs.

Carl Boyer, III has been doing genealogy since 1964, and has published many books. He published the fourth edition of his book on this topic in 1993. In 2001 he produced two volumes of *Medieval English Ancestors*, and his 2004 release, *Medieval Welsh Ancestors*, is unique. In 1999-2000 he served as national president of Healing the Children, and he is now working to help the schools of Nicaragua through the formation of sister school relationships with schools in California. He will provide the latest information on publishing and answer your questions. Carl has been a long-time supporter of SCGS and has exhibited for many years at SCGS's annual Genealogy Jamboree.

Bring a brown bag lunch and join us for an informal session at noon, followed by Carl's presentation at 1p.m. The SCGS Library will be open for research following the lecture.
